Registration Fee for Port Authority Certified M/W/D/SBEs is \$75. For all others the fee is \$100.

Per LOCAL LAW 41 **all construction workers** working on private or public projects are required to complete a 10-hour course in construction safety approved by the U.S. Department of Labor Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA). This plan requires that within the **preceding five calendar years**, all workers should have completed the 10 hour OSHA training. This includes all active trade workers as well as managers, foremen, and project superintendents working on the project site.

The 10-hour program is intended to provide a variety of construction safety and health training to construction workers, foremen, job supervisors, and anyone involved in the construction industry. Workers must receive additional training, when required by OSHA standards, on the specific hazards of the job. Upon successful completion of the course, **participants will receive an OSHA construction safety and health 10-hour course completion card from the U.S. Department of Labor.**
